

# SUPER BOWL SENSATION

*You'll score big points with customers with this bouquet! To keep everyone's spirits high, guests can take the 260Q balloons and wave them about and cheer during the big game!*

## Materials:

- 2 18" "Super Bowl XL" microfoil balloons
- 1 18" "Wilson NFL Football" microfoil balloon
- 1 16" "Assorted Sprays" diamond clear latex balloon
- 2 each
- 11" "Go Team! Stars & Megaphones" ruby red & sapphire blue latex balloons
- 5 5" ruby red and sapphire blue latex balloons
- 260Q ruby red and sapphire blue latex balloons
- Qualatex BalloonRibbon
- Balloon stick or straw
- Container
- Football stickers
- Helium: about 4.5 cu. ft.

## Instructions:

- To make the "gumball" balloon: Insert a straw into an uninflated 5" latex balloon. Then, insert the balloon into the uninflated 16" diamond clear balloon. While holding the necks of both balloons even, place the helium nozzle into the 16" balloon and inflate the balloon about two-thirds full. Remove the nozzle and insert it into the 5" balloon, inflate, and tie the neck. The inflated 5" balloon will block the bigger balloon's neck so the helium won't escape. Insert another 5" balloon into the 16" while releasing the first inflated 5", and continue inflating and tying for a total of five 5" balloons. Then, finish inflating the 16" with helium, tie and attach to a piece of Qualatex BalloonRibbon.
- Helium inflate the 18" foil balloons and attach to BalloonRibbon. Arrange all the helium balloons into a bouquet and tie to the container.
- Air inflate the 260Q balloons, tie and insert into the container.
- Accent container as desired with stickers.
