

FLOATING PACIFIER

Quick and profitable, balloon pacifiers add a creative touch to baby arrangements, shower décor and congratulatory bouquets. Display them in your shop and watch them sell themselves!

Materials:

- 1 16" round latex balloon
- 1 16" GEO Donut or GEO Blossom latex balloon
- 1 350Q latex balloon
- Qualatex BalloonRibbon
- Weight
- Helium: About 15 cubic feet

Instructions:

- Air inflate the 350Q balloon, leaving about 1" uninflated. Bring the ends together and tie.
- Helium inflate the 16" round balloon and pull the neck through the hole of the uninflated GEO balloon. Tie the neck of the 16" balloon to the knot in the 350Q balloon.
- Helium inflate the GEO balloon and tie. Attach BalloonRibbon to the knot of the GEO balloon and attach to a weight.

TIP: Add dimension to pacifiers with double bubbles and gumball balloons!



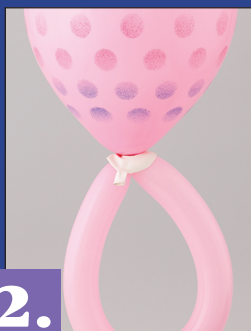
Materials cost: About \$2

How to Inflate GEO Donut & GEO Blossom Balloons

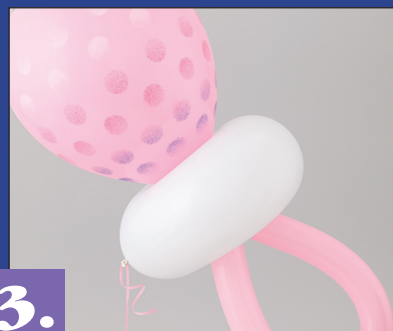
1. Grasp the base of the balloon, not the neck, to prevent inflation into the balloon neck and ensure easier tying.
2. Inflate the balloon to its full, designated size for maximum float time.
3. Tie the balloon as high up on the neck as possible to maintain its special shape.
