

# All-Around Congratulations

**Estimated cost: Under \$3**

**Labor: About 10 minutes**

**Suggested retail price: \$25-\$30**

## Materials:

- 8 11" green rainbow SuperAgate latex balloons
- 4 11" "Graduation Hats" diamond clear latex balloons
- Qualatex MasterBow ribbon
- Helium: none

## Instructions:

1. Air inflate two SuperAgate latex balloons to the same size and tie the necks together.
2. Repeat to make a second pair. Then twist the two pairs together, making sure the balloons intersect at the knots so the center stays constant.
3. Repeat to add two more pairs, one at a time, separating the previous balloons to keep the center constant. For the last two pairs, use the "Graduation Hats" latex balloons. Tie the balloons together as close to the neck roll as possible.

Then, wrap the pairs in, one at a time, to complete the round ball.

## Tip:

Float air-filled topiaries from the ceiling with monofilament line or ribbon, or attach the topiary to a pedestal to be used as a table centerpiece. Topiaries look great in all sizes—from 1 inch to 16 inches!
