

# Soaring Success

**Estimated cost: Under \$6**

**Labor: About 5-10 minutes**

**Suggested retail price: \$25-\$35**

## Materials:

- 1 24" "Congrats! Cap" white latex balloon
- 2 5" ruby red latex balloons
- 2 5" onyx black latex balloons
- 1 260Q ruby red latex balloon
- 1 260Q onyx black latex balloon
- 1 24" white balloon net

Qualatex BalloonRibbon

Basket

Weight

Helium: 5 cubic feet

## Instructions:

1. Fully helium inflate the 24" balloon.
2. Tie the balloon to a weighted Qualatex BalloonRibbon and drop the weight in the basket.
3. Create a four-balloon cluster with the 5" balloons inflated

to 3". Attach to the neck of the 24" balloon.

4. Make two curly 260Qs. Twist the two balloons together at the halfway point to make a cluster. Wrap the cluster onto the neck of the 24" balloon, above the collar. Arrange the 260Qs between the 3" balloons.
5. Cover the balloon with the net, adjusting the net strings until they are even. Tie the net strings to the basket rim and trim the excess.
6. Remove the weighted ribbon, and decorate the net and anchor points with ribbon as desired.

## Tip:

Add a special surprise to the basket (we used themed plush) or use it to receive cards at a party! ■
