

# Balloon Recipe

## Baby Boy Bundle of Joy

*A profitable Bubble Balloon "pacifier" floats atop this celestial-themed bouquet, which can be easily customized for a baby girl.*

**Estimated Cost:** Under \$9

**Labor:** About 20 Minutes

**Suggested Retail Price:** \$35-40

### Instructions:

1. Air inflate four 11-inch Pearl White latex to 8 inches and tie into two pairs. Twist the pairs together to make a four-balloon cluster. Tie the weight to the cluster. Set aside.
2. To make the "pacifier," helium inflate the Bubble Balloon until the wrinkles on the seam disappear. Set aside. Inflate the 260Q, leaving about 2 inches uninflated, and tie the ends together to make the "handle." Tie the handle to the Bubble's neck through the center of the uninflated 16-inch GEO Blossom, then fully helium inflate the GEO. Cut off the Bubble's attached ribbon and tie a new piece of ribbon onto the GEO's neck, so the pacifier will float at an angle. Set aside.
3. Helium inflate the remaining latex and Microfoil balloons, and tie each one to BalloonRibbon. Arrange the bouquet as shown, with the pacifier at the top, and tie the bouquet to the weighted base from Step 1.
4. Tie a bow made with the MasterBow Ribbon into the center of the four-balloon cluster.



### Materials:

- 1 22" "Baby Boy Moon & Stars" Bubble Balloon
  - 2 18" "It's A Boy Celestial Blue" Microfoil Balloons
  - 1 16" White GEO Blossom Latex Balloon
  - 4 11" Pearl White Latex Balloons
  - 2 11" "Baby Moon & Stars" Pearl Light Blue Latex Balloons
  - 1 260Q Pale Blue Latex Balloon
- #9 "Baby Boy/Blue" Qualatex MasterBow Poly Ribbon
- Qualatex BalloonRibbon
- Sand Weight
