



Balloon Recipe

Double the Fun with Minnie

Delight customers with this easy-to-create delivery, featuring minimal product yet lots of perceived value. Make a Mickey version by simply changing out the balloons.

Estimated Cost: About \$14

Labor: About 15 Minutes

Suggested Retail Price: \$35-40

Instructions:

1. Inflate two Wild Berry 11-inch latex to 7 inches and tie into a pair. Repeat to make another pair. Wrap the two pairs together to make a four-balloon cluster. Tie the weight to the center of the cluster.
2. Make a four-balloon cluster of fully inflated 6-inch latex Hearts and tie into the cluster from Step 1, rotating it so it nests.
3. Remove a Double Bubble from the package and use scissors to carefully cut a slit in the outer plastic. Cut around the plastic to remove the inner shape. With a hand pump, slowly inflate Valve B of the inner shape. Use the attached ribbon to tie the shape into the clusters at the base.
TIP: *Cut off the attached ribbon and use it to roll up and tie the neck of the shape before tying into the base.*
4. Use a latex regulator to helium inflate the second Double Bubble according to the directions on the package, making sure all the wrinkles in the seam disappear. Use the attached ribbon to tie the balloon into the weighted base.
5. Fully inflate the remaining four 6-inch Hearts and make a four-balloon cluster. Wrap the cluster onto the neck of the Double Bubble from Step 4. To do this, separate two of the balloons in the cluster, push the cluster high onto the neck of the Bubble and twist together the two balloons that were separated.

Materials:

- 2 24" "Minnie Mouse" Double Bubble Balloons
- 4 11" "Birthday Shining Star" Assorted Pink & Wild Berry Latex Balloons
- 8 6" Pink Latex Hearts
- Sand Weight
