

# Balloon Recipe



## Materials:

- 16 27" "Taper" Metallic Gold Microfoil Decor Shapes
- Monofilament (Fishing) Line

## TIPS:

- Change the colors of the Tapers to customize the Party Burst for any holiday or occasion.
- Add more value by tying Qualatex MasterBow, Color Curls or curled BalloonRibbon into the center of the Party Burst.
- Use Party Bursts in your store to direct customers toward seasonal or special occasion merchandise.

## New Year's Party Burst

*Long-lasting, air-filled Party Bursts are great for store displays and perfect for decorating New Year's parties.*

**Estimated Cost:** About \$13

**Labor:** About 20 Minutes

**Suggested Retail Price:** \$40-45

## Instructions:

1. Air inflate two 27-inch "Taper" Decor Shapes, and tie the necks together as close as possible. Repeat to make a second pair.
2. Twist the two pairs together, making sure to "lock" the tapers in place.
3. Create six more pairs, and wrap them in one at a time, keeping the center constant.
4. Tie monofilament line or ribbon into the middle of the Party Burst and hang from the ceiling.
